A general guide to the best times to sow, transplant & harvest

Herbs	Position	Beginner Rating	Jan Feb Mar Apr	May Jun July	Aug Sept Oct	Nov	Sow to Harvest	Notes
Basil	• •	3					3 months	Suitable for containers
Bay	•	33					6 months	Best in containers - unrestrained it can reach 18m (60') high. Take indoors during hard frost
Chives*	• •	3					3 months	Attractive flowers. Extremely tolerant of most conditions. Can be grown indoors
Dill	•	33					4 months	Can be grown indoors, Is an annual, so collect seed in autumn for spring planting
Garlic	• • •	3			_		6 months	Extremely tolerant of soil conditions and position
Mint	• •	3					6 months	Invasive - restrict to pot growth. Tolerant of shade. Easy to propagate
Oregano / Marjaram	• •	3					3 months	Very fragrant. Suitable for containers. Attractive flowers. Sweet marjoram less hardy than pot marjoram
Parsley*	• • •	3					3 months	Extremely tolerant of soil conditions and position
Rosemary*	•	3					3 months	Attractive flowers. Can be grown indoors. Suitable for containers
Sage	•	33					6 months	Protect from frost when young. Replace every three years
Star Anise	•	かかか				7	6 years	Requires an acid soil, Frost tender so not suitable to most parts of the UK
Tarragon	• •	33					6 months	Protect from frost especially when young. Replace every three years
Thyme	•	3					3 months	Highly scented when crushed. Suitable for containers
